**PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE POSITION:**

Ability to use or be trained to use a commercial chainsaw and commercial weed wacker and the ability to perform physical labor for the majority of the work day. Typically involving some combination of climbing and balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, crawling, and lifting, carrying, pushing and pulling objects and materials generally of moderate weight, but may require some heavy lifting.

**Requirements: Experience and/or education in drainage and construction practices, and procedures is preferred. Knowledge of county, state, and federal drainage regulations is an important component for this position. An ability to interact with a wide range of factors, personnel and officials, is a requirement. Self-motivation, communication skills are helpful in the performance of this job. Thorough knowledge of safety procedures is needed for the employees in the field in sometimes potentially hazardous conditions. High School Diploma its equivalent or other.**

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**Purpose of Position/ Summary:** Clears drainage obstructions and problem areas, and recommends solutions, when possible, for all county regulated drainage ditches. Responds to concerns about regulated drain obstructions and potential flooding, working on site in the field with Foreman and Drainage and Surveying Administrators. Assists seasonal clearing and snagging field crews in the maintenance of regulated drains; clearing trees, and underbrush and clearing debris from ditches. Travels to work sites to assist completion of projects.

**Essential Duties/Responsibilities:** Work is labor intensive and will require good physical condition for outdoor work. County transportation to job sites only, will be by County vehicle with an equipment trailer. Work apparel is long pants, shirts and shoes with hard soles.
