LAKE COUNTY JUVENILE JUSTICE COMPLEX VISITATION RULES

Hours of visitation are as follows:

Afternoon: 1:30 - 4:00 p.m.

No one permitted after 3:30 p.m.

Evening: 7:30 – 9:30 p.m.

No one permitted after 9:00 p.m.

- Visitors shall include parents, grandparents, step-parents and siblings over the age of 18. Siblings visiting for the first time must bring a birth certificate.
- All visitors must show photo identification.
- All visitors must sign in when asked to do so by Security staff.
- All pockets must be emptied and items must be placed into a locker.
- No items are permitted to be carried into visitation, with the exception of the locker key provided by Security staff.
- No coats, jackets or headwear will be allowed into the visitation area.
- NO PHYSICAL CONTACT IS ALLOWED BETWEEN RESIDENTS AND VISITORS AT ANY TIME.
- No items are to be passed between visitors and residents.
- Residents and visitors are to keep their hands and arms on top of the table at all times.
- Only two (2) visitors shall be allowed per resident at one time.
- Any disorderly visitors or residents will be removed.
- Any visitor that smells of alcohol will not be allowed to visit and will be asked to exit the facility.
- Violation of these rules by a visitor will result in the visitor being removed from the visitation area and further visitation privileges may be revoked.
- If visitation reaches full capacity the length of time per visit shall be limited to twenty (2) minutes per child. Security staff shall monitor the time and advise when time has expired. If attendance goes below capacity, previous visitors will be allowed to re-enter.

- No smoking is permitted in the building at any time.
- In the event of an emergency during visitation hours, the Security staff will advise visitors and residents what actions to take. It is important that their instructions are followed precisely and promptly.
- During severe weather conditions such as a tornado alert, it is advisable to call
 ahead of time to verify that visitation will take place. The number is 219-769-4664.
- In the event that visitation must be cancelled for any reason, signs will be posted in advance when possible.
- The Dress Code is posted as you enter the facility. You may not wear shorts of any kind (cut-off or other), t-shirts, tank tops or halter tops, sweatshirts, torn clothing, mini-skirts, bathing suits or body suits. In addition, shoes with laces must be tied and no slip on shoes will be permitted. Shirts with hoods will be permitted providing the hood is not worn on the head.
