### **Criteria for Eligibility**

Determining factors of placement include, but are not limited to;

Employment and/or employability

**Criminal History** 

Risks/needs assessment score

Residency

Eligibility under statute

#### The defendant must not;

Have multiple prior (history of) convictions involving resisting, violence, weapons or criminal sexual acts,

Have history of escape and /or absconding,

Have been expelled or discharged unsatisfactorily from a prior community correction program,

Be a flight risk or a threat to the physical safety of the public,

Have serious mental or physical illness that hider their abilities to follow the guidelines of LCCC.

Have a conviction of an ineligible offense in less than seven (7) years prior to current conviction.

# Community Corrections ineligible offenses by statute as defined in 38-38-2.6-1(b) Defendant must not be CONVICTED of any of the listed crimes.
